

Health and Safety Plan: Tuscarora Intermediate Unit 11

Amendment #2

Effective: March 1, 2021 until the Governor or the General Assembly lifts the current pandemic state of emergency.

When Mifflin County falls under the **Low Positivity Transmission Rate** for two or more consecutive weeks, the percentage of office personnel permitted in the McVeytown office will be 100% and the office will remain open Monday through Friday.

When Mifflin County falls under the **Moderate Positivity Transmission Rate** for two or more consecutive weeks, the percentage of office personnel permitted in the McVeytown office will be 50% and the office will remain open Monday through Thursday. The office will be closed on Friday for cleaning and ventilation.

When Mifflin County falls under the **Substantial Positivity Transmission Rate** for two or more consecutive weeks, the percentage of office personnel permitted in the McVeytown office will be 25%. The office will be closed on Friday for cleaning and ventilation.

All other aspects of the Health and Safety plan required by the PA DOH remain in effect including masking, social distancing, and travel restrictions.

In person training or professional development are not permitted during times of substantial and moderate positivity transmission rates. During low positivity transmission rates, 50% of the training room capacity may be utilized for face-to-face meetings and trainings. All required PA DOH precautions will be utilized.

Staff not scheduled to work in the building on a given day are expected to work remotely.
